Application Guidelines for Professor Position at the Faculty of Agriculture, Iwate University

The Faculty of Agriculture at Iwate University is seeking applications for one Professor position. The selection process will adhere to the university's established procedures.

1. Position and Number of Openings: Professor, 1 position

2. Affiliation:

The successful candidate will join the Food Systems and Management Course in the Department of Food Production and Environmental Management, Faculty of Agriculture. They will also be affiliated with the Advanced Agriculture and Forestry, Regional Innovation and Management in the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences (Master's Program). Please note that our Faculty of Agriculture is scheduled for reorganization in the 2025 academic year (https://www.iwate-u.ac.jp/reorganization2025.html). The successful candidate will be affiliated with the Course of Agricultural Science in the Department of Food and Agricultural Sciences, starting April 1, 2025.

3. Specialized Field for Teaching and Research: Fields related to agricultural economics or agricultural social structure.

Note: To ensure a comprehensive educational system, the successful candidate will be required to teach at least one course from the general education curriculum or specialized foundational courses, considering their field of expertise. Additionally, to meet diverse learning needs and utilize advanced media, candidates may need to develop on-demand content for remote classes and create video syllabi (overview introduction). The on-demand content should cover either two 1-credit courses (100 minutes per session, 7 sessions each) or one 2-credit course (100 minutes per session, 14 sessions).

4. Qualifications:

- (1) Possess a doctoral degree.
- (2) Have distinguished research achievements in the fields of agricultural management and economics, suitable for a professorship, and be capable of developing innovative and original research in these areas.
- (3) Be dedicated to the education and research supervision of both undergraduate and graduate students.
- (4) Be willing to actively participate in the practical agricultural management education program of the "Iwate Agri-Frontier School."
- (5) Have the willingness and ability to work cooperatively with university faculty and staff, actively participating in the administration of the university, the faculty of agriculture, and the department.
- (6) Have sufficient language proficiency (Japanese and English) to perform the duties described above.

 - (6) List of external funding obtained (grants, joint research, contracted research, etc.)
- (7) Names, affiliations, addresses, phone numbers, and emails of two referees who can provide references on the applicant's research, educational achievements, and personality.
